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AMDEC Registration Agreement

You (or your son/daughter) have recently registered in (an) online course(s) through AMDEC. After carefully reading this *Registration Agreement*, please download, print and sign the *Application for Registration* form to verify that you understand and agree to the following:

- I am responsible for establishing a schedule that meets both AMDEC's due dates (outlined in the chart below) and my needs (e.g. completing the course by the end of first semester or meeting post-secondary mark submission deadlines). Students are encouraged to complete their course(s) prior to the final due date.
- I must begin working on my AMDEC course(s) as soon as I have been granted access to the course.
- I must actively participate in my course(s) at least once per week.
- If I fail to participate in my course(s) weekly, and/or fail to meet the due dates posted below, I understand that I risk being removed from my course(s).
- In addition to submitting all work assigned by the teacher, I may be required to participate in group discussions. Registration in math classes requires that I **fax** in my work.
- I will ensure all submitted work is my own. I will abide by the rules and procedures in the *AMDEC Student Handbook* (available at <http://www.amdec.ca>) including those related to academic honesty.
- Between Sept 1, 2009 and May 21, 2010, I may submit a maximum of 2 modules per course per week, and between May 24, 2010 and June 4, 2010, I may submit a maximum of 1 module per course per week.
- I will write my final exams under the supervision of an approved proctor at an Ontario school.
- My communication with AMDEC will take place via FirstClass email. If I am under the age of 18, I must provide a valid parental email to AMDEC for communication purposes.
- Changes to my enrolment status at my school may affect my eligibility to take/remain in courses with AMDEC.

The last day to write a final exam is June 14, 2010 . Completed final exams must arrive at the AMDEC office no later than 12:00 noon on June 16, 2010 .
